

SWEAT SYSTEM TRANSLATION UTILITY

PRELIMINARY USER'S GUIDE

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The Translation Utility provides the means to convert data files created by the SWEAT Editors into files which may be included in AMAC assemblies. Operation of the utility is very simple. After selecting the TRANSLATE option, enter the name of the data file to be translated. Since the utility will translate data from any of the editors, the input file name must be completely specified. (There is no default extension provided). If the file is a valid SWEAT Editor data file, the contents will be displayed, and loaded when the user presses START to proceed.

The Utility will provide a default output file name (as described below). This can be changed by pressing DELETE and re-entering another output file name. After the translation is completed, the Main Menu is redisplayed.

The default output file name is formed with the same name as the input file, and an extension which identifies the file as an AMAC-includable SWEAT file. The third character of the name extension is a digit which identifies the SWEAT Editor that created the data.

NOTE: When the utility generates an 'ORG' statement in an output file, it appears as a comment. (An asterisk is placed in column 1). The user must edit the file in order to 'activate' the 'ORG' statement.
